Overdue book			Assaulting a member of staff LT/HT ACTION
Inadequate work			Possession, use or supply of drugs or other illegal substances LT/HT ACTION
			Behaviour that endangers other students, staff or visitors LT/HT ACTION
Students who have accumulated 4 warnings in a month (and not already been issued with a detention) will be issued with a lunchtime detention.			Persistent defiant and disruptive behaviour after failed intervention strategies LT/HT ACTION
